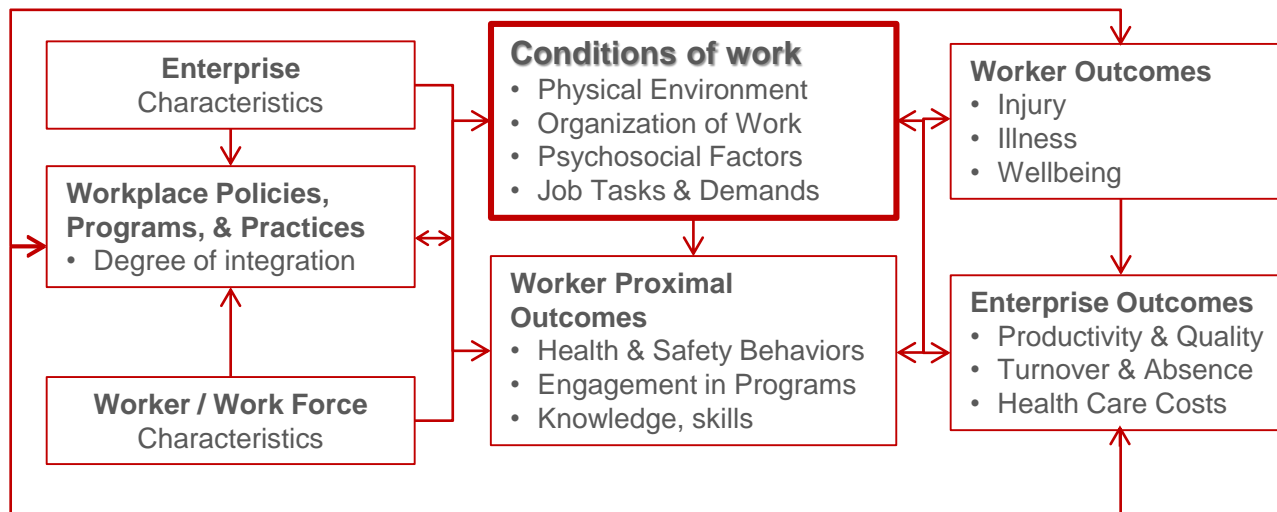
Translating Research to Practice

- Assessing & incorporating partners' needs and priorities

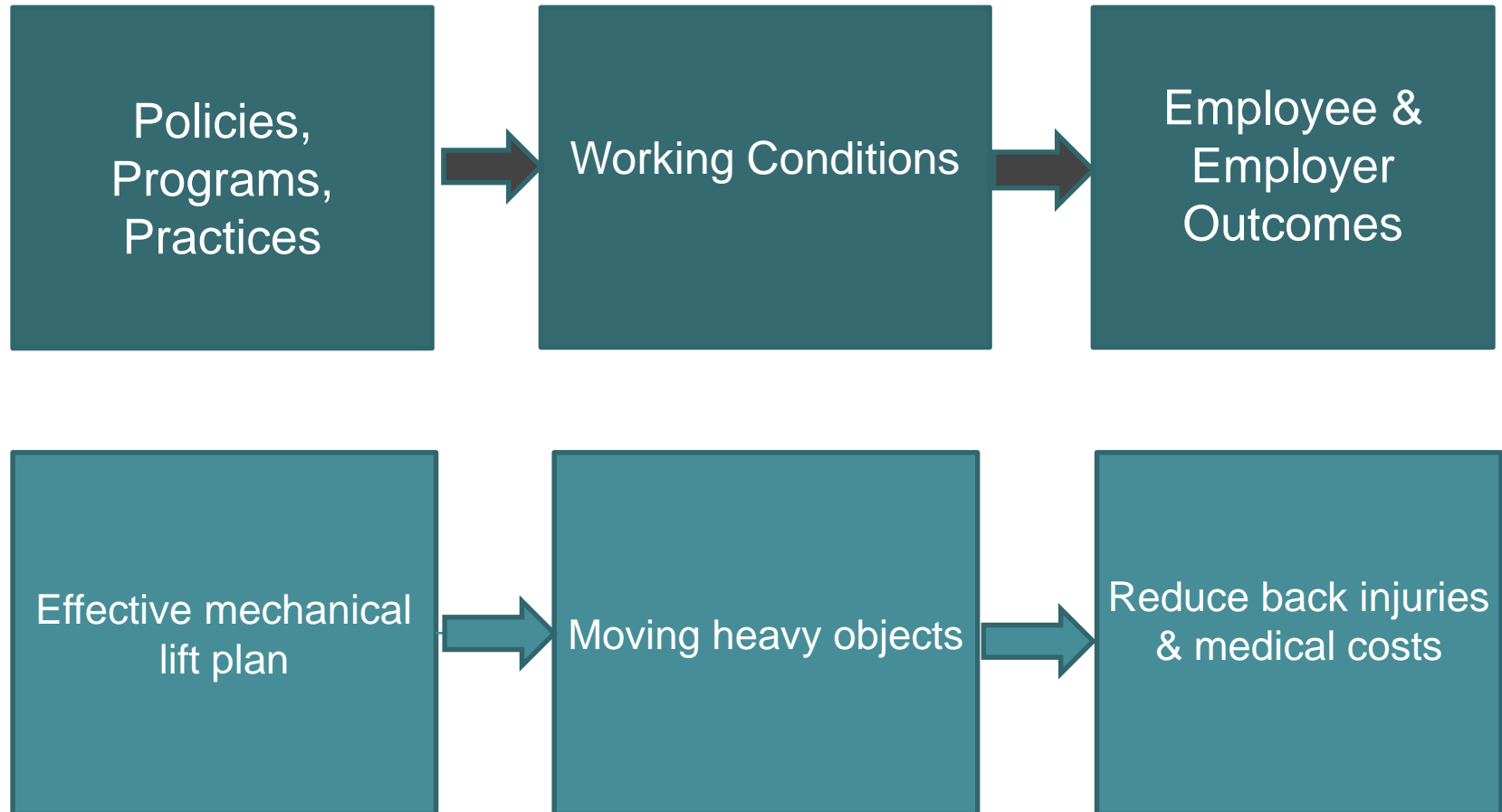


Conceptual Model: Modifying Working Conditions for Improved Outcomes
